DISASTER PLAN/CATASTROPHIC DISASTEER

The first step of our schools should take in preparing for these types of emergencies is to assess the natural disaster risks in the areas.

- Hurricanes
- Extreme heat.
- Wildfires.

In times of crisis schools must function temporarily. Feeding, sheltering, administering First Aid and handling mental health needs could become extended school responsibilities. In case of a natural disaster, such as a Hurricane, we will follow Miami-Dade County Public Schools when closing and reopen after we have assessed damages. After the storm classes might not resume immediately and the students and family must check our website and emails for the latest updates.

We prepare and inform students and parents about post-storm plans in terms of staying up to date on course material. Assess the risk for damages to the property that may occur during a hurricane. Remain up to date with news. If a hurricane is approaching, the NOAA (National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration and National Hurricane Center) will alert us.
